This wine tasting included one white and three reds from northern Spain
The individual ratings ranged from Mediocre to Exceptional by **16 participants** before disclosing their prices.

1 st	Uro Toro 2016	Total Quality Points: Q= 49; Q/\$ = 1.22
2 nd	Borsao Tres Picos 2019	Total Quality Points: Q= 44; Q/\$ = 2.00
3 rd	Txomin Etxanix 2021	Total Quality Points: Q= 41; Q/\$ = 2.05
4 th	Vina Rubican 2021	Total Quality Points: Q= 23; Q/\$ = 1.64

Best Buy: a tie between Borsao Tres Picos 2019; Txomin Etxanix 2021

Note: Numbers in the chart indicate the number of participants that rated the wine with the corresponding quality level. In parentheses are equivalent numerical values conversion used to calculate the numerical indexes: one Mediocre= 0, one Acceptable= 1, one Good= 2, one Very Good= 3, Very Good= 3, one Excellent=4 and, one exceptional= 5
